About the Hagerty Drive It Day

Drive It Day® takes place every year to raise money for and to draw attention to the Federation of British Historic Vehicle Clubs and other charities. The Federation is a grouping of over 450 clubs and museums together with some 1500 trade and individual supporters. The aim is to uphold the freedom to use old vehicles on the roads without any undue restriction and to support its member organisations in whatever way it can.

Hagerty International is pleased to support the Federation with this event, which will be the fourth Hagerty Drive It Day®. The goal is for everyone to have fun, and to enjoy the cars, the drive and the company of like-minded enthusiasts. Special thanks to Silverstone Racing Club, Silverstone Circuits and Sywell Aerodrome for their part in making this possible.

Route

The route will be approximately 70 miles and include all road types. Each entrant will receive a 'tulip' style roadbook. The route will be run in two directions with the focus on the **Sywell Aerodrome** and the **Sywell Aviation Museum** in Northamptonshire.

Sywell is a busy aerodrome with a small and interesting museum. It is a great place to stop and the Art Deco **Aviator** hotel is the perfect place for a cuppa and to meet other entrants.

This year we hope that you will be able to drive your car on Silverstone Circuit, as previously, but we cannot guarantee it. This is because of the major works being done to accommodate the MotoGP race as well as the 2010 British Grand Prix, which Silverstone has managed to retain. However the Silverstone Racing Club is as always a fun place to visit and gives a chance to see some of the very major changes going on at the circuit.

Hot soup rolls and soft drinks will be provided prior to the start. Drinks and refreshments will be available for purchase from the Silverstone Racing Club clubhouse, which will be the rendezvous on your return.

Eligibility

Subject to the terms printed in this form, cars registered before 1st January 1990 may be entered subject to places being available. There is a limit of 150 cars.

Cost

Entry, which has been organised by Hagerty International Limited, is free. However the purpose of the event is to raise money for the Federation of British Historic Vehicle Clubs, the Warwickshire and Northamptonshire Air Ambulance and give a contribution to Sywell Aviation Museum. We would respectfully request that each entrant send a minimum of £20 as a donation towards these. Cheques should be made payable to Hagerty International Limited. All money received will be donated.

Start Point & Start Time

The start point will be Silverstone Racing Club, Silverstone Circuit, NN12 8TN.

Entrants should arrive at between 10.45 and 12.15.

Cars will be flagged off progressively from 11.00.

It is anticipated that the event will be over by 18.30.
